Hugh Hamilton – “The Scoundrel”



Brief Tasting Notes

Appearance:

Tempranillo is not actually known for its colour but with careful viticulture and wine-making the colour produced is a terrific deep purple-red hue.

Bouquet:

It's a very expressive wine with spiced aromas of anise and clove. Its fruit characters are beautifully evident: maraschino cherries and mulberries.

Palate:

The aim in making this wine is to faithfully represent the variety so Hugh Hamilton picks it at just the right time: not too ripe, not too green. This ensures a savoury note to the distinctive late-palate tannins and avoids excessive warmth and high alcohol content. It's spicy, fleshy and generous yet pleasantly drying.
