Brief Tasting Notes

Appearance: Bright, ruby red

Nose: Minty berry

Palate: The palate is succulent with the complex tastes of berries, black olives and spice. There is body to this wine generated from the supple tannins and integrated oak. This wine has a long and persistent after taste which satisfies the palate.

James Halliday: "Bright colour; McLaren Vale has always produced bouncy, juicy merlot, and this is no exception; the flavour is given complexity by a distinctly savoury, black olive, finish"
