Brief Tasting Notes

Appearance:
Deep crimson

Bouquet:
You can just detect the heady orange blossom scent of the Viognier over the Shiraz..

Palate:
The berry character of the Shiraz is there on the palate, enhanced by some spicy stone fruit flavour from the Viognier. The wine spent some time in French & European oak barriques (225 litre casks), some of them new, to further integrate the flavours and complete the wine. All of this begs the question for you to answer, which variety is Jekyll and which is Hyde?
